


- General Checking Account Balance as of 7/31/18: \$ 37,223.39.
- Benevolence was \$1,161.00 with a total for the year of \$6,574.00 which is 43.7% of our goal.

September council Member of the month is Jack Houser.



#### The Recipe Swap

This month's recipe: Coffee Cake
Submitted by Carla Mae Carl.



#### **Coffee Cake**

2 sticks of margarine 2 tsp vanilla

2 cups sugar 2 tsp baking soda

4 eggs 1/4 tsp salt

1 (16 oz.) sour cream 3 cups sifted flour

(fold in flour and do not beat)

Topping Mixture prepared separately:

1 cup sugar

3/4 cup chopped nuts

2 tsp cinnamon

Mix together in a small bowl

Cream softened margarine, sugar and vanilla. Add eggs and beat well. Fold in sour cream. Sift remaining dry ingredients together and fold into mixture (Do not use mixer for the dry ingredients.)

Place 1/2 of the batter into a greased 9 x 13 pan. Sprinkle 1/2 the cinnamon, sugar and nut mixture on top of batter and gently pull knife through to partially mix into the batter. Add remaining batter and then add the topping mixture, and again pull knife through to add the topping mixture into the batter.

Bake at 350 for 45 - 50 minutes.




