Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy”. The Third Commandment is given so that, as Martin Luther puts it, “we do not neglect God’s Word and the preaching of it, but regard it as holy and gladly hear and learn it”.

I highlight this commandment to encourage you to attend worship this summer, here at Christ’s United Church when you are at home, and at a congregation nearby when you are traveling. Participating in services at another congregation is a wonderful way to celebrate how other Christians engage “in prayer, praise and thanksgiving” (as Luther puts it in his explanation to the Second Commandment). If you worship elsewhere this summer, please bring a bulletin back with you – no, not to prove that you did worship on vacation, but so that I too can learn how others worship.

Speaking of worshipping in other congregations, recall that our Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) is in Full Communion, since 1997, with the Presbyterian Church USA, the Reformed Church in American, and the United Church of Christ. Since 1999 we have been in Full Communion with the Episcopal and Moravian Churches. Ten years ago, we got around to also being in Full Communion with the United Methodist Church. And we’ve been in dialogue with our Roman Catholic brothers and sisters since July, 1964!

## **Our approachable Lord**

There is not a hint of one person who was afraid to draw near [Jesus]. There were those who mocked him. There were those who were envious of him. There were those who misunderstood him. There were those who revered him. But there was not one person who considered him too holy, too divine or too celestial to touch. There was not one person who was reluctant to approach him for fear of being rejected. Remember that. —**Max Lucado, *God Came Near***



But there is another reason I bring up the Third Commandment. It is a reminder to experience relaxation and renewal on a regular basis. Our Jewish siblings did no work on the Sabbath day; they instead enjoyed time with family and neighbors. It is not God's desire that we go around continually exhausted from running ourselves ragged. As evidence, look at Mark 6:31 where Jesus says, "Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while". For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat". And the beloved Matthew 11:28, "Come to me, all you that are weary and carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest".

It is my prayer that during these summer days you experience renewal both through worship and relaxation.

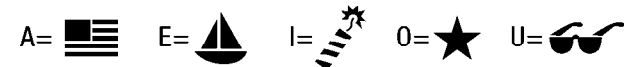

- WELCA will donate funds to pay a mortgage payment for August. Quilts and kits will be blessed on June 16 and a \$150 donation was made to the Capital Campaign on Father's Day in honor of the fathers of Christ's United.
- A unanimous decision was made by the Personnel Committee to present Jamie Johnson as the candidate to hire to fill the Director of Music Position.
- The alarm system upgrade has been installed.
- Eight members of CULC attended the Active Shooter Seminar at Good Shepherd. Pastor Laura made contact with Police Chiefs from Ashland and Butler Township to do a safety walk through of our church in the near future.
- We received a letter from Peg Bianca, Executive Director of “Helping Harvest” (formerly Berks Food Bank) thanking us for our recent donation of \$421 toward the purchase of new trucks.
- Matthew Chester, A North Schuylkill student is planning a Blood Drive for his Senior project to be held at CULC on July 22, 2019 from 1:00—6:00 p.m.


